All the stickers carry a Biblical truth about our identity. Take time to listen to God and ask which of the stickers He wants you to wear today.

Which part of the truth about your identity is God speaking over you in this moment?

For children who are less confident in hearing from God this is a great tool, even if they are uncertain they can know that whichever sticker they have picked is true of them.

Release children to bless others in your group or congregation by inviting them to share stickers or to ask God which sticker He would like them to give to somebody.

Why not use the stickers as an evangelistic tool encouraging children to place stickers on postcards with messages from God. Pray and ask God for a picture or clue about who He wants you to give the sticker/card to. Head out together on a 'treasure hunt' and try to find the person God wants you to share the message with.
